- Palmetto Summerville Behavioral Health offers a specialized military program for male and female children and adolescents ages 7-18 years.
- Military families may experience many unique changes to their family dynamics. These changes can include deployments, relocations, and other mental health diagnoses affecting family members. They may result in complex emotional, behavioral, and psychiatric symptoms for children and teens.
- Residents are thoroughly evaluated by a Psychiatrist and a customized treatment plan is established to promote emotional development.
- All of our Therapists are licensed in their specialties and have wide ranges of experiences working with the military family as a whole and the situations that are particular for military families.
- Therapeutic treatment can change unhealthy behaviors and give children and adolescents the best chance for a successful and brighter future.

The Following Services Will be Provided to the Youth and Family by Palmetto Summerville:

The assessment and services are provided in an effort to give both the family and child the support and resources needed to rebuild their family unit. Within this model, licensed staff will evaluate and assess the youth in areas of mental and behavioral health, as well as, conduct a thorough medication assessment and stabilization of medications in a controlled, supportive environment.

- **Clinical Interviews are completed.** These structured interviews are used to evaluate the client's history, strengths, and presenting problems.
- **Full Psychological Evaluation** will be completed by a Licensed Psychologist.
- **The Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory (SASSI)** to support Secondary Substance Abuse and **The Trauma Symptom Checklist for Children (TSCC).**
- **Intensive Group Therapy** to address grief/loss issues, abandonment, and/or attachment issues.
- **Intensive Family Therapy** to address family issues to reunify family and preserve the family environment.
- **Each youth** will also receive standard admission assessments:
 - History and Physical
 - Psychiatric Assessment
 - Medication Management
 - Nursing Assessment
 - Restorative Independent Living Skills Assessment
 - Spiritual Assessment
 - Elopement
 - Suicide Assessment
 - Psycho-Social Assessment
 - Recreation Assessment.
